**Title:** Reporter

**Reports to:** Managing Editor

**Contract:** 12 month contract role based in Chiang Mai; freelance reporters in Thailand or Myanmar are also welcome to submit CVs for regular freelance commissions.

**About the role:** Your job will be to write features about important issues in Myanmar, under the supervision of the Managing Editor and the team of Editors. You will write high-quality articles that go deeper than conventional daily news reporting, collaborate on investigations and offer readers a critical perspective on events in Myanmar.

### **Key responsibilities:**

- Write high-quality feature articles (over 2,000 words) for the Frontier website in English or Burmese.
- Conduct research using a range of sources
- Prepare and conduct interviews
- Check facts and ensure accuracy of writing
- Work independently and with other members of the newsroom to investigate issues of public interest in Myanmar through a critical lens.
- Meet tight deadlines, communicate regularly with editors and take part in routine editorial meetings where you will pitch new story ideas.
- Maintain high standards of professionalism, in the newsroom, while on assignment, in internal and external communication, and on social media.

- Good contacts in Myanmar's political and military sectors, armed actors and civil society
