The project:

Doh Athan, "Our Voice", is a weekly programme covering human rights issues in Myanmar. It is available online, via social media, and on Voice of America's (VOA) Burmese service. It includes audio, videos and articles for the web. Doh Athan is produced by Fondation Hirondelle, a Swiss based organization, in partnership with Frontier Myanmar and with local reporters and media from different states, regions and ethnicities in Myanmar.

Doh Athan is seeking freelance contributors who can originate, research and produce audio programs and short videos on human rights issues. This is an excellent opportunity to develop your own stories and share them with a wide audience online and on radio, working alongside an award-winning team of journalists.

- At least 2 years as a videographer

- Technical knowledge of audio-visual equipment and systems
- Experience writing scripts or feature print stories for publication
- Trained in media, journalism or communications
- Excellent spoken and written Burmese
